**Request for Official Information responded to under the Local Government and Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) (the Act) – reference: OIR 2223-315**

I refer to your information request we received on 7 July 2022 for the following:

***Please advise in respect of Te Urihi a.k.a. The Gateway planned for Paraparaumu Beach.***

- 1. The total amount that has been spent on this project to date, including but not limited to: Payments to Architects, Engineers, external Lawyers; government departments and agencies.***

The total amount spent on the Te Urihi project to date is \$1.22M. This has been spent over the last three financial years as follows:

- 2019/2020 = \$282,000
- 2020/2021 = \$354,000
- 2021/2022 = \$586,000

- 2. The expected cost of the Resource Consenting process and any other presently underway reports.***

It is difficult to give an exact cost just for the resource consent process. An approximate cost of \$280,000 can be attributed to date to the consent process. Noting this is included in the overall total of \$1.22M.

We have estimated a further \$50,000 - \$70,000 for the resource consenting process to complete the limited notification process via the hearing for affected parties that made a submission.

There are no reports currently under way.
