#### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

#### **DELEGATION**

The Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board has delegated authority as at section D of the Governance Structure approved by Council on 26 October 2016:

Approving criteria for, and disbursement of, community-based grant funds as approved through the LTP or Annual Plan.

#### BACKGROUND

- An amount of \$21,850 is provided in the 2018/19 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board and grants are funded from that budget.
- In addition, the amount of \$200 was returned by a grant recipient from the previous year, whose group subsequently disbanded.
- Accountability reports on grants allocated are required two months after the event or activity for which the grant was awarded takes place.

# Applications to the Community Grants Fund

The following activities can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

#### Asthma New Zealand

Funding of \$500 (plus GST) is sought to assist with the cost to purchase tables and chairs to deliver their free service to the community.

#### Kapiti Ballet Society

8 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with costs to hold their annual competition event

#### Kapiti Boxing Club

9 Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with costs towards accommodation in Taupo when attending the Golden Gloves competition.

#### Kapiti Community Patrol
