I strongly oppose the proposed plan to rezone the section of land at 65-73 Ratanui Road in order to build a retirement village there. The reasons for my opposition are:
Ratanui Road is the beginning of the semi rural area of Otaihanga. It has significant natural beauty and an established semi rural character. Building a retirement village on such a large plot of land would destroy that. The proposed village will bring far too much traffic to Ratanui Road. Ratanui Road already experiences lots of traffic in the mornings when college starts and in the afternoons when college ends. This traffic will already get worse when the Mansell development on Otaihanga road is inevitably built. Building a retirement village too will tip it over the edge. There will also be an increased risk of car accidents occurring on Ratanui Road/the roundabout area because the mix of drivers will be the very young (reckless college age drivers) and the very old (doddery and slow)that is not a good mix!!
- There is almost certainly no one in the surrounding area who would support such a village being built. The council should listen to the views of those people whose properties are in the area and should prioritise those voices over the corporation that has bought the land. Kapiti has enough retirement villages already and it will soon lose what little remains of the sleepy semi urban/rural charm it once had. I know you won't listen to this submission and will change it anyway based on this or that need or a weighting of the options or whatever but THE ONLY RELEVANT FACTOR is what those people in the immediate impacted area desire.
