## Mackays to Peka Peka and what's happening in your area

### TE MOANA ROAD DIVERSION AND NIGHT WORKS

On Monday 9 May we're planning on carrying out night works to install two cross heads at the Te Moana Interchange. Then we're planning to carry out night works again from Monday 16 to Wednesday 18 May to install bridge beams across the road.

So we can carry out this work safely, we've constructed a 200m temporary road diversion through the project site at the Te Moana Interchange. On the nights mentioned above between approximately 7pm and 5am, we'll divert traffic onto this temporary road. These works are being carried out at night to avoid disrupting daytime traffic.

We'll do everything we can to stick to these dates, but they do depend on timing of the beam placements at the Waikanae River over the next week and a half. We'll let you know as soon as these dates are finalised.

Safety is our priority so please take extra care along Te Moana Road and observe speed restrictions, traffic management and detours when they're in use. Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding while we carry out this work.
