Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of **31 January 2024** requesting the following information:

1. Can you tell me the full range of plans the Council may have under consideration for the vacant section on 146a Weggery Drive?

Council has resolved to dispose of the vacant section at 146a Weggery Drive, Waikanae. Following this resolution, a two-lot subdivision was applied for prior to sale. No further plans have been considered.

2. Has the section on 146a Weggery Drive been approved by KCDC for subdivision into two lots? If not, why not?

The subdivision application is on hold pending consultation with local iwi Ātiawa ki Whakarongotai (Ātiawa). The consultation taking place relates to the cultural significance of the site.

3. Why hasn't KCDC put the land up for sale?

The matter was placed on hold while Covid 19 and other projects took priority. Efforts to engage with Ātiawa have resumed.
