Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of **22 November 2025** requesting the following information:

- 1. Can you please provide me with a copy of the contract that KCDC has with its nominated contractor for the sweeping of the roading infrastructure in the KCDC district?***

Road sweeping services are part of the larger Roding Maintenance Contract that Council has with the Te Ara Tu Alliance.

You can find the list of current roading contracts on the Council websites under Services – Roads, transport and parking.

A copy of the Road Maintenance Contract will not be provided. This information is commercially sensitive and is withheld under section 7(2)(b)(ii) of the Act. Section 7(2)(b)(ii) provides that Council may withhold information in order to protect information where the making available of the information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied it, or who is the subject of the information. I am satisfied that the withholding of this information is not outweighed by public interest considerations in section 7(1) favouring release.

- 2. Was the specific need for road sweeping put out as a public tender process or is it part of a larger contract that KCDC has with its roading contractor?***

As mentioned, road sweeping is part of the larger Road Maintenance Contract.

Please note that any information provided in response to your request may be published on the Council website, with your personal details removed.

3. What were the criteria that KCDC used when deciding and approving the nominated contractor for road sweeping?

An Open Tender process was carried for the Road Maintenance Contract that covered an assessment of experience, skills and technical expertise for the services required.

4. Does KCDC have multiple contracts with multiple roading contractors and if so, can you please provide me with an overview of the structure that KCDC uses?

Yes, there are multiple contracts in place for a variation of roading services.
