Thank you for your email received **26 February 2025** requesting the following information:

***1. What is the amount of money the Kapiti District Council is paying sustainable coastlines for each beach audit in the region?***

Sustainable Coastlines are required to deliver 32 surveys at a total cost of \$43,269.57, which equates to \$1,352.17 per audit survey.

***2. How many audit sites are required to have data collected and what is the total amount of audits required for the year***

There are 7 coastal and 1 stream sites that are surveyed each quarter with a total 32 surveys annually.

***3. Are sustainable coastlines being paid additional funds to carry out beach clean ups in the area?***
