Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of **12 May 2026** requesting the following information:

Repair work has been undertaken on the carpark/service road surface around 180-188 Kapiti Road starting the week of May 4th 2026. Please provide the cost of this work to KCDC, a breakdown of that cost, and how this cost is arrived at. Please also advise what quality assurance, project control, cost and schedule oversight, etc. is undertaken (or not) by KCDC.

The cost of this repair is expected to be under \$2,500. It involves a 16 sqm digout. The work will be claimed at the tendered m² rate with our maintenance contractor. This rate is all-inclusive.

The compaction of the digout is checked using a Clegg Impact Soil Test before the asphalt finish is applied. A joint final measure-up is then carried out between the contractor and Council. This is where quality assurance is undertaken on the finish and housekeeping of the site.
