PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1. Four applications for funding have been received:
 - Actively Coping with Cancer Programmes
 - Kapiti Songsters Choir
 - Kapiti Youth Support
 - Nicola Bell

DELEGATION

2. The Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board has delegated authority as at section D of the Governance Structure approved by Council on 26 October 2016:

Approving criteria for, and disbursement of, community-based grant funds as approved through the LTP or Annual Plan.

BACKGROUND

- 3. An amount of \$21,850 is provided in the 2018/19 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board and grants are funded from that budget.
- 4. In addition, the amount of \$200 was returned by a grant recipient from the previous year, whose group subsequently disbanded.
- 5. Accountability reports on grants allocated are required two months after the event or activity for which the grant was awarded takes place.

CONSIDERATIONS

6. Grants are allocated in accordance with established criteria (attached to this report as Appendix 1).

Applications to the Community Grants Fund

Actively Coping with Cancer Programmes

7. Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of hall hire for the community-based programme for cancer patients and their support whanau.

8. This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Kapiti Songsters Choir

- Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of hall hire for weekly choir rehearsal sessions.
- 10. This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Kapiti Youth Support

- 11. Funding of \$3,581.09 is sought to assist with the cost of a venue for hosting an after-function for Anzac Day commemorations.
- 12. This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Nicola Bell

- 13. Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of attending the *Slingababy Babywearing Consultancy Course* being held in Wellington in November 2018.
- 14. This application can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Financial considerations

- 15. An amount of \$21,850 was provided in the 2018/19 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board.
- 16. In addition, an amount of \$200 was returned by a group who had been granted funds in the previous financial year but had subsequently disbanded.
- 17. This provided a total of \$22,050 available for granting in the current financial year.
- 18. To date in the current financial year, the amount of \$6,611.75 has been granted.
- 19. The balance remaining for granting in the 2018/19 year is \$15,438.25.
- 20. The total of applications under consideration in this report is \$5,081.09.
