SUBJECT: Reikorangi and Waikanae Beach Community Outcomes

This memo is to update you about the potential to develop Local Outcomes Statement for Reikorangi and Waikanae Beach.

Reikorangi

In 2012 Council staff attended a number of meetings at the invitation of members of the Reikorangi community, to discuss the process of developing Local Outcomes. The community did not pursue this particular direction. Instead they focussed on specific areas such as input and feedback on the Proposed District Plan. At this stage there has been no request from Reikorangi community members to continue any work on the Local Outcomes and it is not included in the development management work programme.

Waikanae Beach

The potential to develop Local Outcomes for Waikanae Beach has been mooted as a way of addressing possible long term impacts of the expressway as well as any current place-based issues. At present there is no staff capacity to assist the Waikanae Beach community in this process. Any work on local outcomes could not be undertaken before the end of the 2014 calendar year. The current priority is Waikanae Town Centre and the Community Board will be briefed in March about the scope and progress on this project.
