#### **DELEGATION**

# Applications to the Community Grants Fund

### Art Studio Kapiti

- Funding of \$343.20 is sought to assist with the registration fee and associated costs for the community-based arts group to participate in the Kāpiti Arts Trail on 27 and 28 October, and 3 and 4 November 2018.
- 7 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity and Eligible Purpose 4: To partially or fully offset the cost of any Counci permit, licence or resource consent fees.

#### Babes + Picnics
