## CLUB-LICENCE

Sections 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

### Waikanae Boating Club Incorporated Licence Number 45/CLUB/089/2023

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), Waikanae Boating Club Incorporated is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at Waimea Road, Waikanae Beach and known as Waikanae Boating Club, for consumption on the premises, to any person who is—

- a member of the club; or
- on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with Part 7 of the Act.

#### Conditions

1. Alcohol is only permitted to be sold, supplied and consumed on the premises authorised by the licence, which are more precisely identified as outlined in the plan held on file dated 6 July 2019.
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday – 12 noon to 10.30pm**
3. A certificated manager, or an acting manager whose name is displayed as duty manager, must be on duty on the premises when the bar is operating on the following days and times:  
**Fridays from 4pm until close, Saturdays from 3pm until close, and during fishing competitions**
4. Substantial food options such as those described in the application, or variations of a similar range and standard, must be available at all times the premises are open for business.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low alcohol beverages and ensure that water is freely available for patrons at all times in clean drinking vessels.
6. The licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed premises detailing information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.
7. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and to intoxicated persons.
8. The whole of the premises is **undesignated**.
9. The licence must be displayed in the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons using the premises.
10. The licensed premises situated at Waimea Road, Waikanae Beach are more precisely identified as outlined in the plan date stamped as approved by the District Licensing Committee on 6 July 2019 (held on DLC file CL801).

#### Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if has never been renewed before, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if has never been renewed before, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

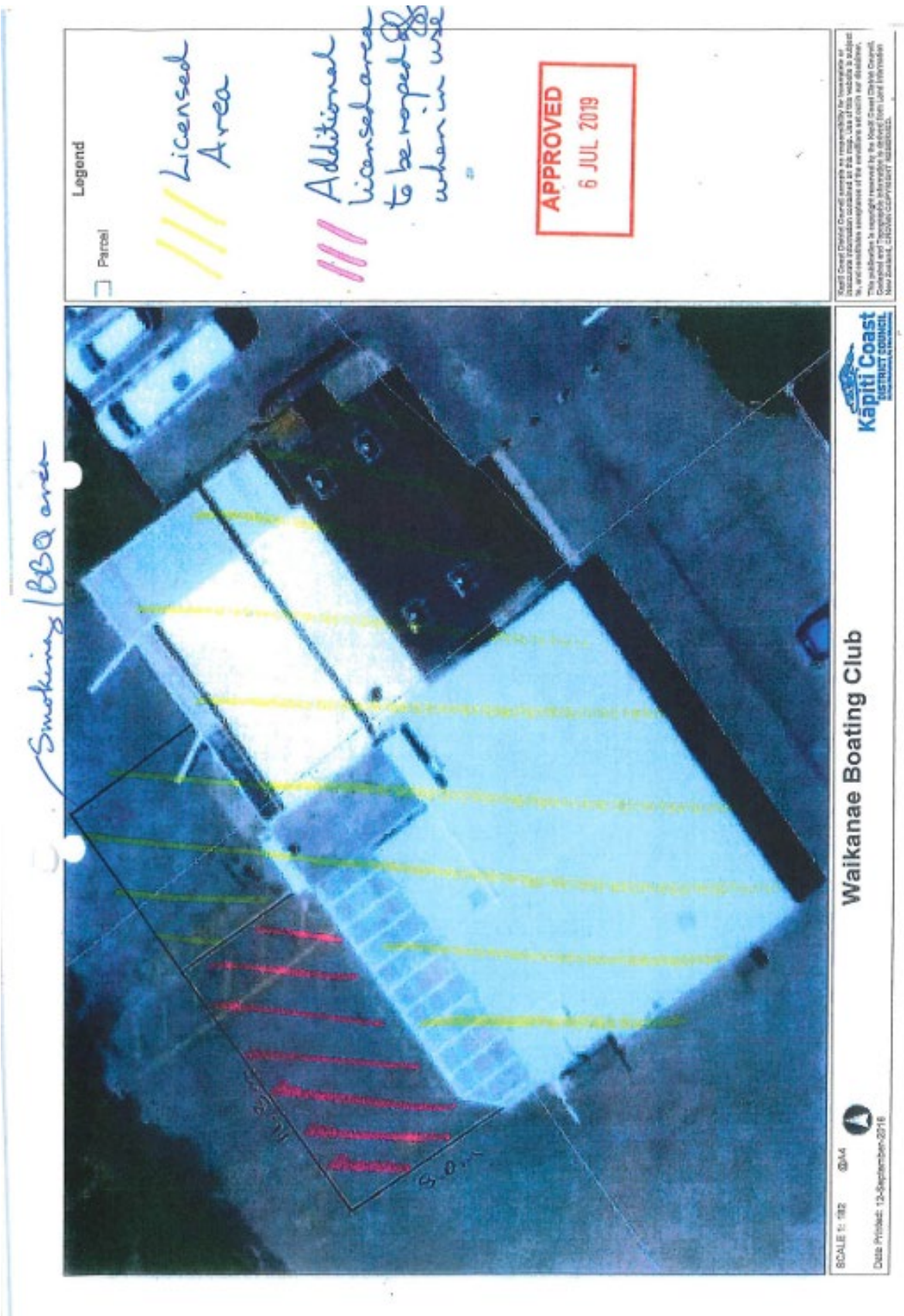
