NB: this application can be considered under Eligible Purposes 3: activities that encourage the development of cultural, sports, environmental, social or educational activities within the local district.

8. Kāpiti US Marines Trust:

The Kāpiti US Marines Trust has applied for a grant of \$350 to assist with the costs of publication of a brochure to advertise the work of the Trust. NB: this application can be considered under Eligible Purposes 3: activities that

encourage the development of cultural, sports, environmental, social or educational activities within the local district.


