Raumati Intersection – roundabout and safety improvements (2021/2022)

These proposed changes are significant, so we want to know what you think. If changes do go ahead, we will work to minimise any disruption to businesses. These improvements are subject to securing funding from NZTA and Council.

This proposal includes:

- A roundabout at the intersection of Raumati Road and Rosetta Road to improve the way the intersection works and reduce speeds.
- Raising the pedestrian crossings onto safety platforms and reducing crossing distances to improve pedestrian safety and reduce vehicle speeds.
- Installing a new raised safety platform with a central pedestrian refuge on Matatua Road to improve pedestrian accessibility and reduce speeds.
- Altering the Margaret Road and Raumati Road intersection to improve vehicle access and reduce the distance pedestrians have to cross.
- Reducing lane widths to promote slower speeds meaning we can reallocate some of the road space for wider footpaths and things like seating and bike parking etc.
- Reviewing parking spaces to allow for the safety improvements.

We'd like to know how you currently use this intersection and how you would like it to work for all users. This will help us make sure improvements work for everyone.

There will be further chances to have your say as the project progresses.

Timing: Subject to funding this work could take place in the 2021/2022 financial year.
