Thank you for your email of **4 June 2025** requesting the following information:

Manly Street was closed in March with the original timeline stating it would be for about 5 weeks and would be reopened before winter. Work on the Kenakena Stormwater project appears to have stopped/slowed. Are you able provide an explanation as to the delays and why this occurring?

The project has encountered issues with groundwater entering the cofferdam (excavation for pump station build). KCDC has worked closely with the contractor, and we believe we have found a solution to enable the works to progress. Currently we anticipate the road will be opened in October 2025. We recognise this is longer than anticipated and appreciate the community's patience while we deliver this important project for the community.
