Appurtenant hereto is a similar right of way running along the southern boundaries of subdivisions 1, 15 and 14 until same reaches the north western corner of Tutangatakino No. 1 where it turns and runs southward along the eastern boundary of the said Subdivision 14 to a public road.*

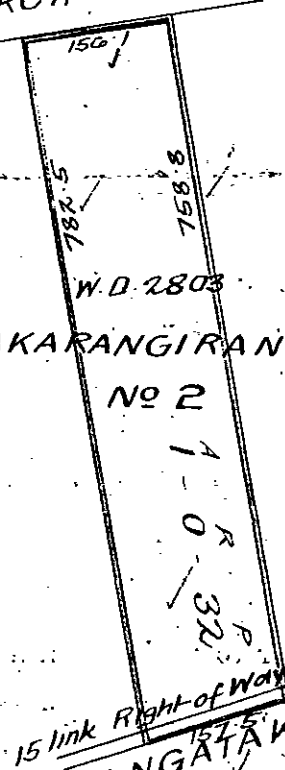
