Request for Information under the Local Government and Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of 27 February 2023 requesting the following information:

This is a request for information regarding the Ōtaki Community Board, which I know recently went through a process of mediation.

Can you please advise:

1. Why was mediation provided?

The Ōtaki Community Board, in consultation with the Mayor, requested mediation to be organised in order for the board to reach consenus on a way forward as a newly elected board, that had not previously worked together. The mediation was organised by Council staff.

2. Was it requested by the board or a member, or offered by council?

Please refer to the response to Question 1.

3. What did the mediation involve – number of sessions, duration, location?

The mediation involved initial one-on-one meetings between the facilitator and each board member, at a location suitable to both parties. Noting that some sessions may have occurred online.

This was followed by two further sessions, including a:

- 4-hour session with the facilitator and all members of the board on 8 December 2022 in the Rimu Room at Coastlands.
- A follow up 2-hour session on 1 February 2023 at the Gertrude Atmore supper room, in the Ōtaki Memorial Hall.

4. Who conducted the mediation?

The sessions were conducted by Karen Vaughan from Hummingbird Effect Ltd.

5. What was the total charge for mediation, and was it a charge to council?

The charge for conducting the facilitation sessions was \$5,175.00 and the cost for room hire was \$201.25 (Coastlands) and \$26.00 (Gertrude Atmore supper room). The total cost was \$5,402.25 and was fully charged to Council.

6. Has the board had mediation in the past to resolve issues, and if so, when?

No, the Community Board has not had any mediation in the past.

7. Have any other Kāpiti community boards had mediation, and if so, when?

As at 3 March 2023, none of the other Community Boards have had mediation.
