I've noticed a traffic monitoring system installed on Arcus Road, which is a cul-de-sac. Could you please clarify the purpose of this monitoring? I'm curious to understand if the data is being collected for any specific improvements or assessments—perhaps relating to future road works, sealing, or other plans. Any insight you can share would be appreciated.

The purpose of the traffic monitoring carried out on Arcus Road is to capture traffic volume and vehicle type data as part of our routine traffic counting programme.

This data is used to establish reliable traffic estimates and growth information for every road section in our district for planning and operational purposes.

The Arcus Road counts are routine and are not related to a specific road improvement project.
