PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1 Six applications for funding have been received:
 - Kapiti Health Advisory Group
 - Kapiti College Women's Rugby
 - Menzshed Kapiti
 - Genaya Naisbitt
 - Our Lady of Kapiti School
 - Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board

DELEGATION

The Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board has delegated authority as at section D of the Governance Structure approved by Council on 26 October 2016:

Approving criteria for, and disbursement of, community-based grant funds as approved through the LTP or Annual Plan.

BACKGROUND

- 3 An amount of \$21,850 is provided in the 2018/19 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board and grants are funded from that budget.
- In addition, the amount of \$200 was returned by a grant recipient from the previous year, whose group subsequently disbanded.
- Accountability reports on grants allocated are required two months after the event or activity for which the grant was awarded takes place.

CONSIDERATIONS

Policy considerations

Grants are allocated in accordance with established criteria (attached to this report as Appendix 1).

Applications to the Community Grants Fund

Kapiti Health Advisory Group

- Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of producing a brochure which will provide information on transport options to Wellington and Kenepuru Hospitals and other Capital & Coast District Health Board services.
- 8 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Kapiti College Women's Rugby

- 9 Funding of \$420 is sought to assist with the cost of providing swimming recovery sessions for 15 selected players.
- 10 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Menzshed Kapiti

- Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of joinery for a new building which will provide more workshop and storage space.
- 12 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Our Lady of Kapiti School

- Funding of \$250 is sought to assist with the cost of providing water kits which will enable the school to become a 'water only' zoned school.
- 14 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.
- This application was received the day of the PRCB meeting on 19 February 2019, and Board members agreed to let the application lie on the table for consideration at the PRCB meeting scheduled for 2 April 2019.

Genaya Naisbitt

- Funding of \$500 is sought to assist with the cost of providing a support group for parents of children with special needs.
- 17 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board

- Funding of \$305.26 is sought to assist with the cost of providing light refreshments to members of the public following the Civic Parade on Anzac Day 2019.
- 19 This activity can be considered under Eligible Purpose 2: Special project or activity.

Financial considerations

- 20 An amount of \$21,850 was provided in the 2018/19 budget for the Paraparaumu/Raumati Community Board.
- In addition, the amount of \$200 was returned by a group who had been granted funds in the previous financial year but had subsequently disbanded.
- This provides a total of \$22,050 available for distribution in the 2018/19 financial year, of which \$10,916.75 has been allocated.
- 23 The balance remaining for granting in the 2018/19 year is \$11,133.25.
- 24 The total of applications under consideration in this report is \$2,475.26.
