The Subcommittee commented on the Table shown on page 3 of the Agenda under Financial Considerations, and asked for the interest earned by the Arthur Thomas Clarke Trust account to be transferred and combined into the Campe Estate Trust. It was noted the Campe Estate principal could be distributed whereas the Arthur Thomas Trust principal could not.

At its last meeting on 24 February 2015, the Paekākāriki Community Board was inundated with applications and on this occasion, recommendations were being made to spend more than the combined interest.

The Campe Estate Subcommittee was asked to increase the funding amount from \$370 to \$500 for the Anzac Day Committee. The Chair said the event organisers had under-estimated the costs.

The Campe Estate Trust considered the three recommendations made by the Paekākāriki Community Board at its meeting on 24 February 2015 and approved payment of the following grants:
