1.	29/1/2013	September 2014	Wellington Road – monitoring	Roading Asset Manager	<p>The School work has been completed with the child figures now attached. There has been positive feedback received from the School and community.</p> <p>There may be another speed survey conducted by students using speed radar guns and the results will be compared to data collected last year.</p>
2.	27/08/2013	September 2014	Visitor Information display boards	Group Manager, Infrastructure Services	A proposal was expected to come back to the next Board meeting on 26 August where a presentation would be made on how the Board might like to manage a strategy around signage through the village.
3.	1/10/2013	September 2014	Ames Street footpath and safety improvements	Group Manager, Infrastructure Services	Speed hump has been installed but needs to be relocated further North. Footpath construction due to start 25 August.
4.	1/10/2013	July 2014	SH1 speed thresholds	Group Manager, Infrastructure Services	Completed. Letters have been sent to NZTA and AA.
5.	1/10/2013	July 2014	Median barrier project	Group Manager, Infrastructure Services	Ongoing monitoring.
6.	19/11/2013	September 2014	Railway Pedestrian Crossing	CWB Coordinator/ Group Manager, Infrastructure Services	KiwiRail have indicated the crossing installation will be completed by the end of August. NZTA have requested the Council double fence the walkway through the paddocks so that they can lease the land for grazing and keep stock off the walkway. The access beside 100 Tilley Road will now be shared.

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7.	29/1/2013	October 2014	Coastal protection upgrade	Coastal & Stormwater Asset Manager	A meeting was held with the community design group 29 July to finalise options. Further work required to detail final costs requires Geotech investigation and consultation would be delayed until after final costs developed.
8.	15/07/2014	October 2014	Aperahama Street residents group	Group Manager Infrastructure Services	Proposed to replace existing lights with LED and look at potential for additional lights if budget allows.
9.	15/7/2014	October 2014	Vehicle engines braking (near the commune)	Group Manager Infrastructure Services	Commune resident raised the issue of engines braking. Group Manager would send background to the Board and find out if this was a Bylaw issue for Council, as well as signage and enforcement.
