Thank you for your email of 15 February 2019, in which you made a request for information. This response is issued in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.

In your request you asked for the following information (in **bold**), please find my response below:

 Of the 118 older person housing units provided by Kāpiti Coast District Council, how many are currently vacant?

As at 1 March 2019 there are no vacant Housing for Older Persons units.

Four units became vacant between 27 November 2018 and 26 January 2019. All four units were re-let to applicants on the applicant register.

What is the average length they have been vacant?

As there are no vacant units, this question is not applicable.

 How many people are currently on the waiting list for older person housing places in Kāpiti, and what was that figure for February 2018, and February 2017.

Applicant Register number - as at 28 February 2019 = 46

Applicant Register number - as at 28 February 2018 = 98

Applicant Register number - as at 28 February 2017 = 99

*The significant reduction in applicant numbers between 2018 and 2019 is due to completion of a full applicant revalidation process in July 2018.
