PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1 This report presents a report and recommendation considered by Paekākāriki Community Board on 12 March 2013.

BACKGROUND

- 3 The Paekakariki Community Board met on 12 March and made the following recommendation to the Campe Estate Subcommittee:

That the Paekākāriki Community Board recommend to the Campe Estate Subcommittee that the capital of the Campe Estate and the Arthur Thomas Clarke Trust funds be combined and that the interest be used for the distribution of funds for the benefit of the residents of the Paekākāriki community at the same time as the Campe Estate distributes its funds every six months.
