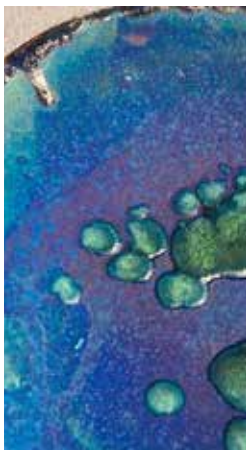

Nestled between the mighty Tararua Ranges to the east, and 40 km of coastline to the west lies the relatively undiscovered Kāpiti Coast. Just 45 minutes' drive north of Wellington, the Coast is a foodie's haven, with cafes, bars, and restaurants for every taste. 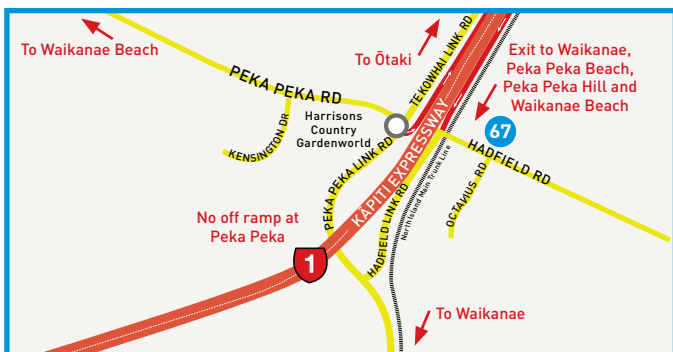

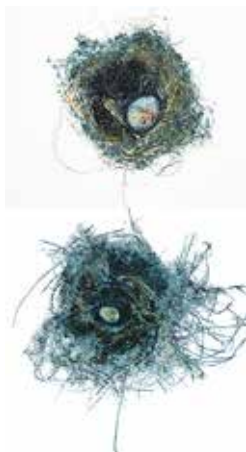
