Kia ora

Thank you for submitting your projects for consideration by the Government under the Shovel Ready programme. It was pleasing to see so many projects submitted that were ready to go and that would help the economy and construction sector recover from the impacts of COVID-19.

The IRG received a total of 1924 submissions across approximately 40 sectors of the economy. Those submissions were scrutinised under criteria set by the Government and a short list of 802 projects presented to Ministers. The Ministers and Cabinet have subsequently given consideration to these projects and agreed to approximately 150.

The Government was looking to support projects that could be under way within 12 months, were of a minimum scale with material employment benefits and which provided national or regional public benefit. In addition to supporting larger construction projects, IRG Ministers also chose to place more focus on smaller, community-focused projects, such as civic and social infrastructure.

The value of the submitted projects was much greater than available funding for this programme of work, and so not all projects were able to be included for support.

Unfortunately, the projects listed in the attached table are not included in the final list of projects under the Shovel Ready programme and so are not being progressed further.

You are receiving this email on behalf of your organisation. Please can you ensure all relevant people within your organisation are informed of this letter.

We realise that this will be disappointing to you, and we appreciate the effort that has been made in submitting this to the Government for consideration.
