SUBJECT: Traffic Resolutions (ATM2025-06-1 to ATM 2025-06-17)

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To seek retrospective approval from the Manager Access and Transport for several traffic resolutions under the Kāpiti Coast District Council Transport Bylaw 2022.

DELEGATION

The Chief Executive has delegated the following powers to the Group Manager Infrastructure and Asset Management, Manager Access and Transport and Principal Advisor Infrastructure and Asset Management:

Delegation of authority to exercise and administer the responsibilities, duties and powers of Council under the Transport Bylaw regarding significant safety issues including but not limited to imposing such prohibitions, restrictions, controls, or directions under the bylaw by way of publicly notified resolution.

BACKGROUND

- Following the adoption of the Transport Bylaw 2022 several significant safety issues on the Kāpiti Coast roading network have been addressed with 'No stopping' markings or Stop controls.
- These markings and controls were put in place over the period June 2020 to February 2025.
- Council is now regularising the changes that have already been put in place in order to comply with publication requirements in the Bylaw.

Safety assessment

- 6 Officers assessed each site and concluded that one or more significant safety issues existed:
 - 6.1 as outlined in attachment 1 (Traffic Resolutions Kāpiti Coast District Council Transport Bylaw 2022 – ATM 2025/6-1 to ATM 2025/6-17: FINAL); and
 - 6.2 required addressing under the Transport Bylaw 2022.

Options

7 Where no stopping restrictions were proposed two options were investigated as outlined below:

Option	Description	Comment	
1	Install No Stopping Road markings	Drivers may not stop, stand or park on No Stopping Road markings.	
		 Markings extend continuously along the extent of the parking restriction. 	
		Standard practice is to mark No Stopping Road markings.	
2	Install No Stopping signs	Drivers may not stop, stand or park in the area always designated by the sign (i.e. 24 hours, 7 days a week).
