Request for Information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) (the LGOIMA)

Thank you for your email of **10 June 2026** requesting the following information:

1. *The date KCDC first entered a contract with Capital Football to use the Mazengarb Reserve sports field.*

No contract is in place with Capital Football as this is not required of routine Code bookings for bona fide use of the fields for their intended purpose. For seasonal use of the sports fields, Capital Football simply books the fields on behalf of the sporting Code for them to undertake scheduled football matches each season.

This part of your request is refused under section 17(e) of the Act as the document alleged to contain the information requested does not exist.

2. *The duration of that contract.*

3. *The amount of all revenue received by KCDC from Capital Football including hire fees under the terms of their contract.*

- 4. A copy of the contract between Capital Football and KCDC so we can understand the terms and conditions of Capital Football obligations as the hirer.**

- 5. A copy of the turf assessment report before the commencement of the 2025 Capital Football contract, and a copy of the turf assessment report at the end of their 2025 season.**

No turf assessment report of this nature exists therefore this part of your request is refused under section 17(e) of the Act as the document alleged to contain the information requested does not exist

- 6. Details of the recent construction of the dog run at Mazengarb Reserve, the rationale for this expenditure, the cost to construct and the date it is due to open for public use.**

The Mazengarb Reserve Dog Exercise Area has been constructed to provide a dedicated space for dogs to exercise off-leash, while also helping to reduce the impact of dogs on the Mazengarb sports fields and other shared-use areas.

This facility gives effect to the direction set under the 2019 Dog Control Bylaw and Long-term Plan funding in response to community requests for additional fenced dog exercise areas for the district. Mazengarb Park was deemed the most appropriate location in Paraparaumu.

The cost of construction to date is \$65,281.20 +GST, with final costs pending the installation of dog drinking fountains.

The opening of the dog exercise area is currently dependent on the completion of the drinking fountain installation and the establishment of grass following additional seeding. The facility is anticipated to be open for public use by late June 2026, subject to these works being completed.
