**Request for Information under the Local Government and Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act)**

Thank you for your email of 15 September 2022 requesting the following information:

***Is the Council similarly prepared to receive [Council interprets this as ‘release’] the advice it has received on s6(a) and (h) of the RMA and on the NZCPS?***

Your request was clarified by you on 20 September, as follows:

***Can the Council please release any advice, reports or information it has received been privy to, including email communications and internal information on the relevance of section 6(a) of the RMA as it relates to Plan Change 2. Specifically, the table at section 2.1.1 of the s32 report omits any comment on section 6(a), and therefore by reason of omission the Council has clearly identified that section 6(a) is not relevant. Please supply any information that addresses the Council’s decision to omit any reference to section 6(a) as a matter that is not relevant to the plan change.***

Council believes the only relevant information is in publicly available [Intensification Assessment Report \(appendix L to the s32 report\)](#), specifically the first line in the table on page 22.

***The s32 report addresses the NZCPS however I would like to request any advice or information that the Council has obtained on the relevance of the NZCPS as it relates to PC2.***

Council believes the relevant information is:

- Line 4 of the table on page 23 of the [Intensification Assessment Report \(appendix L to the s32 report\)](#) refers to the NZCPS.
- [Appendix B of the S32 report](#) summarises all the “advice or information” received from submitters on draft PC2 that has relevance to the NZCPS.
- The entirety of the attached SLT Paper (Date: 13 December 2021; Subject: Considering Coastal Erosion Hazard as a Qualifying Matter through the Intensification Plan Change)
- The entirety of the attached DRAFT SLT Paper (Date: 30 November 2021; Subject: Considering Coastal Erosion Hazard as a Qualifying Matter through the Intensification Plan Change).
