PC2 - Waikanae Beach building intensification in the designated Old Beach precinct

I oppose the intensification of building density in the Old Waikanae Beach precinct because it lacks the drainage infrastructure to support more buildings and associated runoff. Currently building water catchment (ie roof runoff) is dropped into water tanks and then overflow drops into soak pits. The increase in the size of the homes being built in the area and the number of homes now permanently occupied, as opposed to being primarily a summer holiday settlement, plus rapidly rising water table and the frequent property flooding that causes in heavy rain events is exacerbated by the inability of soakpits to handle the water. Quite simply the groundwater flows up through the pits and overflows. The soak pit solution of earlier times is no longer fit for purpose. The new district plan needs to start with building sufficient drainage infrastructure in old settlement areas before any consideration should be given to allowing increasing building and population density in those area. The blanket directive from the government - agreed between the major parties - gives little room it would seem for councils to make provision for a region's special characteristics; those features which draw people to want to live there.
